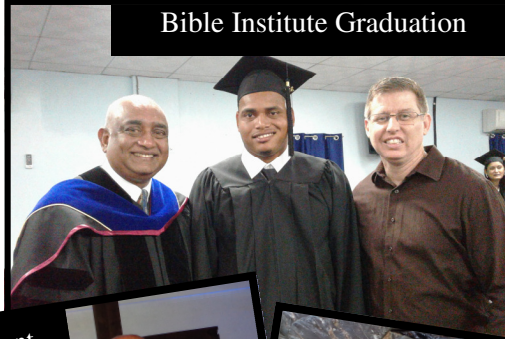


Newness of Life
