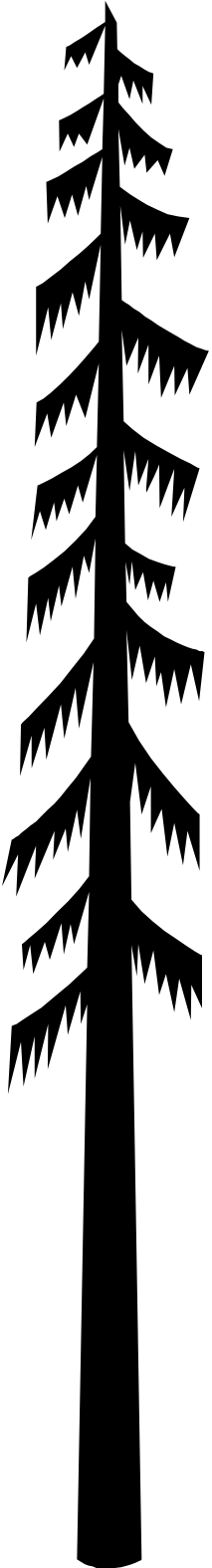

### The Scope of Our Task

#### I. “Go ye therefore”

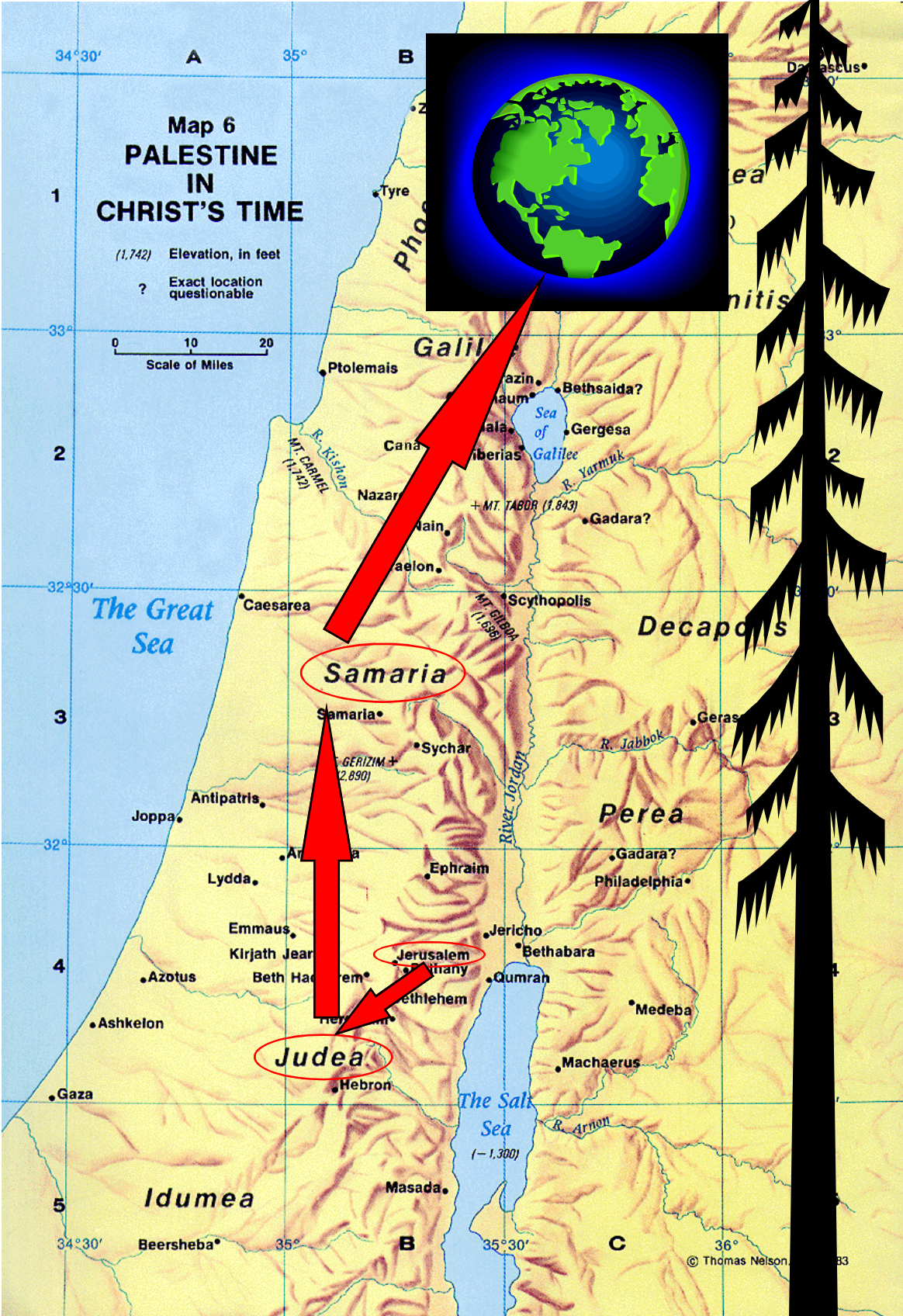
- Jerusalem— home

- Uttermost part of the earth— extreme

#### II. “Teach all nations”

- The Greek word translated here as “teach” has the idea of “ make disciples or followers ”
- Jesus is telling us to go and help people of every nation become His followers .

#### III. “Baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost:”

- We need to help his followers take the first step in their new relationship with Christ .



IV. “**Teaching** them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you.”

- When a person receives the gift of eternal life and becomes a follower of God, this is only the beginning.
- We have a responsibility to teach new believers the Bible.
